The Provost is pleased to announce the formation of the Diversity Education Task Force. This Task Force will review the University of Maryland's provisions for diversity education and to make recommendations for improving them. The group will consider the current diversity requirements within the university's General Education program, as well as ways to articulate them with the educational efforts underway or proposed for other parts of the campus, to foster a more inclusive and respectful community. The task force will take into account national conversations about diversity and explore research and best practices for diversity education used by our peers. It will recommend how to achieve our goals via General Education and other educational or training initiatives (such as those offered in Resident Life, Education Abroad, student organizations, etc.). In addition, the task force will consider provisions for civic education and civic engagement in current educational efforts and make recommendations about their potential expansion.
